Interventions

Contribution towards the salary of SEN & Inclusion Lead and TAs to deliver intervention programmes to support children

Aim/outcomes: To accelerate rates of progress in all subjects across all year groups

Books

Purchase of reading books including Read, Write Inc., maths and literacy workbooks for PP families to link the work in school with support of the parent at home.

Aim/outcomes: Increased attainment in Reading, Writing and Maths and improved home/school links

Educational Resources

ICT provision such as Times Table Rock Stars, Accelerated Reader, Junior Librarian which can be accessed at school and at home

Resources for parental craft afternoons

Aim/outcomes: Increased attainment in Reading, Writing and Maths and increased parental involvement

Talk Boost & Numbots

Programmes purchased and in place for EYFS and KS1 for identifying and supporting language delays and numeric skills

Aim/outcomes: Improved communication leading to increased attainment in Reading, Writing and Maths

Assessment

School has bought published tests to help aid assessment and give children experience of answering comprehension and test questions

Aim/outcomes: To reduce the gap between disadvantaged and non-disadvantaged pupils

Inclusion and Nurture

Support around attendance, transition and vital links to outside agencies including community police as well as emotional support for children

Aim/outcomes: To promote a positive learning culture within school where all children are able and ready to tackle the learning of each and every day, increase attendance

School Sports Partnership

Funding used for SSPP to provide specialist PE provision throughout school

Aim/outcomes: More specialised provision. Increased understanding of a healthy life style, promoting a sense of well-being

Uniform

Funding to support families with additional costs e.g. Uniform, resources, Beehive access where required.

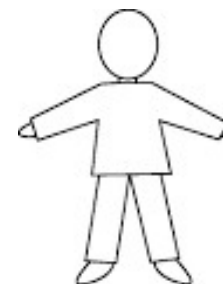
Aim/outcomes: To promote a sense of well being, inclusivity and increased attendance.
