

## Overview of French Curriculum – Year 6

<p style="text-align: center;">Year 6</p> <p style="text-align: center;">A l'école</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Understand numbers 1-100 and use them in context</li> <li>• Identify and tell the time to the nearest 15 minutes</li> <li>• Use the verb 'to like' in both the positive and negative, use the verb 'to go'.</li> <li>• Use adjectives to make writing more descriptive, such as describing their opinions on school subjects.</li> <li>• Use conjunctions such as 'and', 'also', 'because' to extend writing.</li> <li>• Read or listen to longer passages and answer more detailed questions.</li> <li>• Understand what a fully conjugated verb looks like and what each of the pronouns are in the verb 'to like'. Children should understand the infinitive form, the stem and verb endings and be able to identify these.</li> </ul>	<p><b>Speaking</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Use spoken language to initiate and sustain simple conversations on familiar topics.</li> <li>• Present to an audience about a familiar topic (this could be a role-play or a presentation).</li> <li>• Use conjunctions to link together their ideas to add fluency.</li> </ul> <p><b>Listening</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Understand the main points in passages of language spoken with authentic pronunciation and at authentic speed.</li> <li>• Understand and identify longer and more complex phrases and sentences and answer questions based on what they hear.</li> </ul> <p><b>Reading</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Read aloud with expression and accurate pronunciation.</li> <li>• Read and understand the main points and more specific details from a variety of simple texts in different but authentic formats (e.g. reading exercises with set questions).</li> </ul> <p><b>Writing</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Write longer sentences and short paragraphs from memory or using a word bank.</li> <li>• Use verbs in the correct form to express what they and others like.</li> <li>• Identify and use adjectives correctly, as well as using conjunctions.</li> </ul> <p><b>Grammar</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Continue to understand the concept of gender (masculine &amp; feminine) and which article (definite or indefinite) to use correctly with different nouns.</li> <li>• Understand what a fully conjugated verb looks like, and what the personal pronouns are.</li> <li>• Identify and correctly use adjectives and conjunctions.</li> </ul>
